For example %20 is the percent encoding for the binary octet 00100000 ABNF %x20 which in US ASCII corresponds to the space character SP Sometimes the spaces get URL encoded to the + sign and some other times to %20

What is the difference and why should this happen? MetaByter I think it is more technically correct to phrase the question as In a URL should I encode the spaces using %20 or + in the query part of a URL? because while the example you show includes spaces only in the query part it might not be clear to all readers that the answer depends Apr 18 2013 310 A bit of explaining as to what that %2520 is The common space character is encoded as %20 as you noted yourself

The % character is encoded as %25. The way you get %2520 is when your url already has a %20 in it and gets urlencoded again which transforms the %20 to %2520

Are you or any framework you might be using double encoding Dec 14 2019 I am interested in knowing why %20 is used as a space in URLs particularly why %20 was used and why we even need it in the first place Since it's not mentioned anywhere in the grammar the only way to encode a space is with percent encoding %20

In fact the RFC even states that spaces are delimiters and should be ignored In some cases extra whitespace spaces line breaks tabs etc
