They have signed terms of unconditional surrender. The president went on to proclaim the following day Sunday September 2 to be V J Day the day of formal surrender by Japan

The United States still marks each September 2 as V J Day with ceremonies honoring the sacrifices of the men and women who served in the Pacific war. D Day was initially set for June 5. D Day was delayed due to poor weather. With a small window of opportunity in the weather, Eisenhower decided to go. D Day would be June 6, 1944.

Paratroopers began landing after midnight, followed by a massive naval and aerial bombardment at 6:30 a.m.

American forces faced severe resistance at Omaha and Utah D Day. The Allies invade Europe. In May 1944, the Western Allies were finally prepared to deliver their greatest blow of the war: the long delayed cross channel invasion of northern France, code named Overlord. D DAY: THE ALLIED INVASION OF NORMANDY. The Allied assault in Normandy to begin the Allied liberation of Nazi occupied Western Europe was code named Operation Overlord.

It required two years of planning, force and logistics build up and extensive training by the United States and Great Britain in the British Isles.

Overlord was one of the most heavily guarded secrets of the war and it. Throughout the day of August 14th, anticipation mounted as people listened to the radio or called their local newspaper for the latest word.

The New York Times announced that its revolving news sign in Times Square would remain on continuously during the wait. Many people lingered below the sign knowing the biggest celebration of all would occur there.

The waiting gave cities throughout the world the flags of freedom to fly over all Europe. Truman said. Truman designated May 8 as V E Day and most of the Western Allies followed suit. The Soviets however designated May 9 as V E Day or Soviet Victory Day based on the document signed in Berlin.

News of Germany's surrender ignited joyous celebrations in cities across the world. By August 1945, the Japanese Empire was on the verge of defeat but still refused to surrender.

However, a new weapon unlike any other would soon help lead to the end of World War II and have ripple effects for decades to come. Dedicated in 2000 as The National D Day Museum and now designated by Congress as America's National WWII Museum, the institution celebrates the American spirit, teamwork, optimism, courage and sacrifice of the men and women who fought on the battlefield and served on the Home Front. The commemorations on January 27 remind us that the Holocaust
