Addiction is defined as a chronic relapsing disorder characterized by compulsive drug seeking and use despite adverse consequences

It is considered a brain disorder because it involves functional changes to brain circuits involved in reward stress and self control Jul 6 2020 Can addiction be treated successfully? Yes addiction is a treatable disorder

Research on the science of addiction and the treatment of substance use disorders has led to the development of research based methods that help people to stop using drugs and resume productive lives also known as being in recovery

People with addiction often have one or more associated health issues which could include lung or heart disease stroke cancer or mental health conditions

They may mistakenly think that those who use drugs lack moral principles or willpower and that they could stop their drug use simply by choosing to. In reality drug addiction is a complex disease and quitting usually takes more than good intentions or a strong will
