Once home to the Chatillon and DeMenil families this historic St. Louis mansion includes the history of our city's founding families and one of the leaders of Westward Expansion The Chatillon DeMenil Mansion is a great place to hear stories of old French St

Louis the western fur trade everyday life in Victorian St. Louis the 1904 St. Louis World's Fair and Cherokee Cave In 1861 the DeMenil family hired English architect Henry Pitcher to turn the farmhouse into a Greek Revival Mansion

At that time they moved into the home permanently We also tell the story of the caves underneath the property the highway system that almost destroyed the house and the preservation efforts that saved it

We are open for tours four days a week and private events are available on the grounds in our Carriage House and in the Mansion itself The house embodies the stories of the families who lived here including members of the founding families of St

Louis and Carondelet a nationally known Western trailblazer the family of an Oglala leader and a literary scholar who was a director of the 1904 Worlds Fair The Chatillons built a four room brick farmhouse on five of those acres in 1849 which forms the original portion of the Mansion

The house was a simple two storied brick structure with four rooms Street parking available on DeMenil and Cherokee Streets. Mansion is open March through December closed January and February. Back to Top Chatillon DeMenil Mansion 3352 Demenil Place St

Louis MO 63118314 771 5828info demenil The design was copied from a mansion owned by her affluent cousin Henry Chouteau. For many years Sophie had admired the house on 12th and Clark Avenues. Emilie died in St. Louis on March 20 1874

She is buried alongside her husband Nicolas in Calvary Cemetery Joyeux Nol et Bonne Anne to you all from the Chatillon DeMenil families

We will be closed for tours during January and February 2026 and will reopen on Wednesday March 4th 2026 We are a historic house museum with a permanent vast collection of mid nineteenth century to early twentieth century furnishings and decorative art

Many of the items in our collection belonged to the DeMenil Family or other influential families here in St. Louis.
