In the mid 1970s scientists warned that man made chemicals in everyday products like aerosols foams refrigerators and air conditioners were harming the ozone layer. At that time they didnt know the scale of the problem. But in 1985 a hole was confirmed in the ozone layer over Antarctica

Mangroves and seagrass meadows are coastal ecosystems that cover a small portion of the total ocean area but collectively are widely distributed on every continent except Antarctica

Mangroves are found in 123 countries worldwide with an estimated Jan 29 2025 The crisis led to the Montreal Protocol a landmark global agreement that has put the ozone layer on the path to recovery. But the Protocol also has the potential to do something else slow climate change

By implementing its key obligations countries could prevent what experts call a massive Jan 7 2025 Some researchers believe the outbreak is a sign of things to come

As climate change rapidly warms the Artic scientists say it could unleash a wave of potentially deadly microbes that for centuries have been trapped in ice Feb 18 2024 In 2023 the world saw new highs of greenhouse gas emissions temperature records tumbling and climate impacts arriving stronger and faster
