Positional asphyxia, traumatic asphyxia, smothering, choking and strangulation. Feb 1 2024 Forensic pathology: Drowning is respiratory impairment asphyxia due to inhalation of water following submersion in liquid. Types of injuries: asphyxia, blunt force injuries, child abuse, pending drowning, elder abuse, environmental deaths, forensic entomology, forensic evaluations of brain contusions, forensic evaluations of spine and spinal cord, traumatic injury, forensic evaluations of traumatic axonal injury, gunshot wounds, sharp force injuries, sudden cardiac death. Blunt force injuries are produced by blunt objects due to different possible mechanisms. Feb 1 2015 CNS, non-tumor, Carbon monoxide injury. Carbon monoxide binds to hemoglobin forming carboxyhemoglobin. This causes a decrease in the oxygen carrying capacity of the blood, leading to tissue hypoxia. Sources of exposure to carbon monoxide include faulty or inadequately ventilated heating sources and engine exhaust. Exposure is most commonly accidental or due to a suicide attempt.
