He subsequently became a noted dance director Classical ballet system of dance based on formalized movements and positions of the arms feet and body designed to enable the dancer to move with the greatest possible agility control speed lightness and grace Dec 12 2025 Rudolf Nureyev Soviet born ballet dancer whose suspended leaps and fast turns were often compared to Vaslav Nijinsky's legendary feats

He was a charismatic celebrity who revived the prominence of male ballet roles and significantly widened the audience for ballet Dec 22 2025 Darcey Bussell British ballet dancer and celebrity of the late 20th century

Renowned for the energy and passion of her performances she was one of the youngest artists to serve as principal dancer in the Royal Ballet of London. Learn more about Bussell's life and career La Fontaine was a French ballerina and the first woman professional ballet dancer

Before La Fontaine's debut in 1681 at the Paris Opera as premiere danseuse in Jean Baptiste Lully's ballet *Le Triomphe de l'Amour* girls' roles on the public stage had been taken by young men Moira Shearer born January 17 1926 Dunfermline Fife Scotland died January 31 2006 Oxford Oxfordshire England was a Scottish ballerina and actress best known for her performance as the suicidal ballerina in the ballet film *The Red Shoes* 1948 She debuted with the Vic-Wells Ballet in 1934

When Alicia Markova left the company the following year Fonteyn took over many of her classical roles including *Giselle* and became a leading danseuse of the Vic-Wells Ballet Nov 8 2025 Companies revisited historical dance forms and ballet practices the revival of the Baroque dance since the 1980s is one example

Artists reconceived much loved Romantic ballets such as *Giselle* *The Nutcracker* and *Swan Lake* Ballet movement in classical ballet any of the formalized actions of a dancer that follow specific rules regarding the positions of the arms feet and body. Ballet choreography is based on combinations of these fundamental movements.
