A snow squall or snowsquall is a sudden moderately heavy snowfall with blowing snow and strong gusty surface winds

[1] It is often referred to as a whiteout and is similar to a blizzard but is localized in time or in location and snow accumulations may or may not be significant. Squalls can occur where there is no large scale winter storm in progress and might only produce minor accumulations. Snowsqualls can cause localized extreme impacts to the traveling public and to commerce for brief periods of time

Unfortunately there is a long history of deadly traffic accidents associated with snowsqualls. Snowsqualls cause a quick reduction in visibility and often result in a quick accumulation of snow. Lake effect snow can sometimes qualify as a snowsquall although it is not always short lived

The most common breeding ground for snowsqualls is near strong cold fronts which mark the arrival of Arctic air in the winter. 4 days ago A winter storm blasting Michigan is bringing ice snow and high winds to the state on Monday Dec. 29 and could cause localized whiteouts known as snowsqualls

Michigan residents are facing a 1 day ago plunging temperatures during and after the snowsquall will cause wet tracks on some roads to freeze instantly and greatly increase the emergency stopping distance. 4 days ago Snowsqualls often associated with strong cold fronts are sudden intense bursts of snow that typically produce an inch or less of accumulation and last 30-60 minutes in a small area according to the National Weather Service Dec 5 2024. When strong winds suddenly blow and heavy snow falls you're in a snowsquall

What to know about the risks and how to stay safe while driving Nov 12 2024. Unlike regular snow showers snowsqualls can cause sudden whiteout conditions dropping visibility to near zero within minutes and creating dangerous road conditions for drivers

According to the NWS Pittsburgh snowsqualls are intense brief bursts of heavy snow typically caused by a thin band of convective clouds that form along cold fronts. Dec 5 2024 The squall will bring sudden bursts of snow strong winds whiteouts icy roads and travel disruptions across the Northeast

Here's what you need to know Dec 17 2024. Typically lasting anywhere from 20 to 30 minutes snowsqualls can rapidly drop heavy snow reducing visibility and making roads slick

They occur when cold air moves over an area of relatively warmer ground which causes the air to rapidly cool and the moisture in the air to freeze creating intense snowfall.
