Mar 31 2025 Few bamboo varieties are as visually striking as *Phyllostachys nigra* commonly called black bamboo. Tall black stalks are accentuated by small medium to dark green leaves and a dense clump forming growth habit

This makes it popular with gardeners looking to create dense hedges or natural privacy screens. WATER: Keep soil moist but not soggy. SIZE: Thick foliage clumps may reach 15 to 20 ft. tall left unpruned. Add an exotic Asian look to the landscape with this rare form of bamboo.

Fast growing upright stems turn black in their second season contrasting nicely with the rich green foliage. *Phyllostachys nigra* Black Bamboo is a beautiful and unique bamboo plant. The legendary Black Bamboo is native to Taiwan and China.

Introduced in 1827 black bamboo became the first hardy oriental bamboo.

New canes emerge green and turn ebony black within two years with sunlight exposure. *Phyllostachys nigra* commonly known as black bamboo [2] or purple bamboo Chinese is a species of bamboo native to Hunan Province of China and is widely cultivated elsewhere. Black Bamboo scientifically known as *Phyllostachys nigra* is a rapidly growing bamboo variety that exudes elegance and serves a multitude of practical purposes.

Originally hailing from the subtropical regions of China, Black Bamboo makes an excellent centerpiece for any garden style, be it tropical or contemporary. There are several varieties of black bamboo and yes, there are both clumping and running varieties.

They each have their own very unique growing conditions and they are not interchangeable.

The 2 major differences in black bamboo are either clumping or running. Prized as a garden ornamental, *Phyllostachys nigra* Black Bamboo is a striking evergreen bamboo with tall, upright, polished black canes that arch slightly at the top. With jet black culms and feathery green leaves, this is perhaps our most sought after bamboo.

Under ideal conditions, Black Bamboo will grow to 35 feet in height with culms over 2 inches in diameter but 25 feet is its average height in most climates. Dec 27, 2023. *Phyllostachys nigra* commonly referred to as black bamboo is a fast growing and striking bamboo species.
