The Music Box Theatre is a Broadway theater at 239 West 45th Street, New York City, United States. It was designed by C. Howard Crane in a Palladian inspired style and was constructed for Irving Berlin and Sam H.

Harris. It has 1,025 seats across two levels and is operated by The Shubert Organization. The largest of the Broadway theaters is the 1,933 seat Gershwin Theatre while the smallest is the 597 seat Hayes Theater.

The beginning of Broadway theater can be traced to the 19th century influx of immigrants to New York City, particularly Yiddish, German and Italian, who brought with them indigenous and new forms of theater. Broadway theatre [nb 1] or Broadway is a theatre genre that consists of the theatrical performances presented in 41 professional theaters, each with 500 or more seats, in the Theater District and Lincoln Center along Broadway in Midtown Manhattan, New York City.

[1][2] Broadway and London's West End together represent the highest commercial theater in the world. The Broadway Theatre, formerly known as the Colony Theatre, B.S.

Moss's Broadway Theatre, Earl Carroll's Broadway Theatre and Cinerama is a Broadway theater at 1681 Broadway, near 53rd Street, in the Theater District of Midtown Manhattan, New York City, United States. Opened in 1924, the theater was designed by Eugene De Rosa for Benjamin S.

Moss, who originally operated the venue as a The Circle in the Square Theatre, colloquially known as the Circle, is a Broadway theater at 235 West 50th Street, within the basement of Paramount Plaza, in the Midtown Manhattan neighborhood of New York City, New York, United States. The Lyceum Theatre, also known as SEE, is a Broadway theater at 149 West 45th Street, in the Theater District of Midtown Manhattan, New York City, New York, United States.

Opened in 1903, the Lyceum Theatre is one of the oldest surviving Broadway venues, as well as the oldest continuously operating legitimate theater in New York City. The Marquis Theatre is a Broadway theater on the third floor of the New York Marriott Marquis hotel, in the Theater District of Midtown Manhattan, New York City, New York, United States.

Opened in 1986, it is operated by the Nederlander Organization.

There are about 1,612 seats in the auditorium [a] spread across an orchestra level and a balcony. Ticket counters of the New York City booth, as seen from 47th Street, The TKTS ticket booths in New York City and London sell Broadway and Off-Broadway shows and dance events and West End theatre tickets respectively at discounts of 20% to 50% off the face value.
