Jun 9 2021 Over the course of 75 years the more than 500 million people who have seen theBlueAngels perform at air shows around the world have witnessed the power and grace of some of the Navys all time classic aircraft

Presented here are historical images of some of these classic propeller driven aircraft and thunderous jets flown by theBlueAngels The firstBlueAngels aircraft flown in July 1946 was the F6F 5 Hellcat aircraft a veteran of World War II

Just a few months later the team transitioned to the F8F Bearcat aircraft. In the fall of 1948 the flight team moved to Naval Air Station Corpus Christi Texas. In 1949 the team relocated to Naval Air Station Whiting Field Florida

Also in the year the insignia of theBlueAngels The firstBlueAngels casualty occurred on 29 September 1946 when Slot Pilot Lieutenant j.g. Ross Robby Robinson failed to recover from a dive while performing at NAS Jacksonville

Robinson was the first of 26Blue Angelfatalities throughout the teams history During the Korean War theBlueAngels were disbanded in 1950 but returned a year later. On Armed Forces Day in May 1954 the flight team performed for the first time with the U.S

Air Force s newly formed demonstration the Thunderbirds

In 1958 the Back to Back Pass and the first six plane Delta maneuvers were added to the performance BlueAngels Hornet at a Glance The F A 18 Hornet has served theBlueAngels since 1987 the longest tenure of any airplane types assigned to the U.S Navy Flight Demonstration Squadron

The Hornets assigned to theBlueAngels have reached their limit when it comes to operational flying from aircraft carriers A 4 at a Glance TheBlueAngels flew the A 4 Skyhawk during the period 1974 1986

Called the Tinker Toy because of its diminutive size the A 4 bore the brunt of Naval Aviations strike effort during the Vietnam War. Vietnam prisoners of war CDR Everett Alvarez VADM James Stockdale and CAPT later Senator John McCain were shot down flying A 4s

A study in simplicity the A 4 Skyhawk Public access to NAS Pensacola will be available from 9 a.m. through 3 p.m. through the West Gate only on the south end ofBlue AngelParkway

Additionally vehicle operators must have a valid drivers license and foreign nationals will need to be escorted by a U.S. citizen
