If breastfeeding were scaled up to near universal levels about 820 000 child lives would be saved every year 1. Globally only 40% of infants under six months of age are exclusively breastfed. WHO actively promotes breastfeeding as the best source of nourishment for infants and young children

This fact May 1 2009 WHO and UNICEF launched the Baby friendly Hospital Initiative BFHI to help motivate facilities providing maternity and newborn services worldwide to implement the Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding

The Ten Steps summarize a package of policies and procedures that facilities providing maternity and newborn services should implement to support breastfeeding. WHO has called upon all Aug 9 2023 Breastfeeding has many health benefits for both the mother and infant

Breast milk contains all the nutrients an infant needs in the first six months of life.
