These levers determine the practical value and influence of the security held by the investor Oct 8 2025 Companies use different share classes like Class A or Class B to structure ownership control voting and prevent takeovers

An example of a multi class share structure is at Google A share class or share classes are usually created from various types of shares in a company

The type of shares and share classes that a company can create is determined and guided by its articles of association also referred to as articles of incorporation Jun 30 2025 Class A Class B and Class C shares are different categories of company shares that have different voting rights and different levels of access to distributions and dividends These classes are usually designated by letters such as Class A Class B or Class C and they can differ in several key ways including voting rights dividend access and other shareholder benefits May 15 2025 Explore the types of stock classes their features and how voting rights dividends and ownership differ between Class A B C and preferred shares Share class refers to the company's bifurcation of its shares into different classes on the basis of their voting rights privileges ownership restrictions such as dividing the common stock into A shares having the most privileged voting rights and B shares who have fewer voting rights and so on Apr 10 2025 While all share classes contribute to a company's capital structure they may differ in terms of voting power dividend rights conversion privileges and liquidation preferences Jan 11 2024 When you own a piece of a company you hold shares that represent your ownership stake
