Closure indicates one complete instance of the action of the verb to close. Closing indicates the action of the verb to close that was uncompleted or still in progress at the time referred to Jul 1 2019 You don't have to go home but you can't stay here is what a bar manager might say to his last remaining customers at closing time

In the old days the cry in the joints when they were ready to close was you don't have to go home but you can't stay here was cited in print in 1944 Aug 5 2020 At I can't get rid of this question what should I say when do you close or until what time are you open? it might sound really silly question but when you asking in your way which one would you prefer and what makes it more comfortable to say? and it might be more silly to ask but I am kind of wondering when do you close sounds a bit direct Oct 13 2021 Now quickly what are its opening and closing times? I mean if there were a single word for both opening and closing a store what use would it be why you'd end up with something like I fungle the store closed at 8 00 and I fungle it open again at 20 00

Linguistic madness! I work in the tech sector where it's common practice for some to work well past the typical 5 or 6pm closing time of many industries

In my sector I've often encountered COB to indicate a deliverable due at the end of the business day ~5 00 6 00pm Jan 2 2018 What is the deadline for something due [ ] days weeks etc

in advance? For example if something is required seven days in advance would providing it on Friday the week before be correct or to Jul 25 2015 What are some formal ways to tell the boss or colleagues in the office you are leaving for the day? I am new to this I googled and found this link but I want some more professional or creative way Nov 2 2018 But with time the boundary problem is trickier

Sugar Fans sweet shop is open from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday. Strange. There seems to be no doubt that the shop opens at 9 and closes at 5. It does not mean that it will be open throughout each hour between 9 and five

It closes at five
