If you say that someone could do something you mean that they have the ability to do it but they don't in fact do it. We use could have to say that someone had the ability or opportunity to do something but did not do it. She could have learned Swahili but she didn't want to. You use could to talk about a possibility, ability or opportunity that depends on other conditions.
