There may be some cases where you have a vanillacreme and a raspberrycreme and those would refer to those as different flavors

You'd never refer to a hamburger and a cheeseburger as different flavors of burgers You find in dictionaries OED for example that what the British call biscuit is called cookie or cracker in America
