In 2014 Russia covertly invaded and illegally annexed Crimea a move that was denounced by the international community Mar 18 2025 Crimea which juts out into the Black Sea off southern Ukraine was absorbed into the Russian Empire along with most ethnic Ukrainian territory by Catherine the Great in the 18th century Aug 18 2025 Soviet leader Nikita Khrushchev transferred Crimea from Russia to Ukraine in 1954 when both were part of the USSR to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the unification of Moscow and Kyiv Aug 19 2025 Crimea's unique location makes it a strategically important asset and Russia has spent centuries fighting for it

The peninsula was home to Turkic speaking Tatars when the Russian empire first annexed it in the 18th century Aug 18 2025 Ahead of its full scale invasion Moscow deployed troops and weapons to Crimea allowing Russian forces to quickly seize large parts of southern Ukraine early in the war Apr 26 2025 It has been 11 years since Russia took control of Crimea but Moscow's invasion of Ukraine has put the peninsula back in the global spotlight
