However, as the aorta grows larger, the risk of tearing, dissection or rupturing increases dramatically Apr 10 2025. An aortic aneurysm is a weak spot in the wall of the aorta that begins to bulge or balloon outward, as shown in the image on the left. An aneurysm can occur anywhere in the aorta.

People with an aortic aneurysm have an increased risk of a tear in the aortic lining called a dissection. It is shown in the image on the right Apr 29 2025. The aorta is the body's largest artery, carrying oxygen-rich blood from the heart to the rest of the body.

When it becomes abnormally widened or dilated, it can signal an underlying issue that may lead to serious health risks if left unmanaged. Some cases remain stable while others progress and require medical intervention.

Because the aorta supplies blood to the entire body, symptoms may appear in other organs or limbs. For instance, if blood flow to the arm or leg is affected, you might experience pain, numbness or even stroke-like symptoms in that area.
