Eskimo skmo is a controversial exonym that refers to two closely related Indigenous peoples Inuit including the Alaska Native Iupiat the Canadian Inuit and the Greenlandic Inuit and the Yupik or Yuit of eastern Siberia and Alaska. Although the name Eskimo was commonly used in Alaska to refer to Inuit and Yupik people of the world this usage is now considered unacceptable by many or even most Alaska Natives largely since it is a colonial name imposed by non-Indigenous people. Dec 10 2025 The term Eskimo long applied to the Inuit may have come from the Mikmaq of eastern Canada who have a word in their language resembling Eskimo that means the eaters of raw flesh.

Inuit never called themselves Eskimos until the term was introduced by the Southerners. There are two main groups of Eskimos: the Inuit of northern Alaska, Canada, and Greenland and the Yupik comprising speakers of four distinct Yupik languages and originating in western Alaska in South Central Alaska along the Gulf of Alaska coast and in the Russian Far East. The meaning of ESKIMO is a member of a group of Indigenous peoples of southwestern and northern Alaska, Greenland, eastern Siberia, and especially in former use arctic Canada. Inuit [a] singular Inuk are a group of culturally and historically similar Indigenous peoples traditionally inhabiting the Arctic and Subarctic regions of North America and Russia including Greenland, Labrador, Quebec, Nunavut, the Northwest Territories, Yukon traditionally [b] Alaska and the Chukotsky District of Chukotka Autonomous Okrug.
