In an average year at least 0.01 inches 0.25 mm of precipitation falls on 150 days more than nearly all U.S. cities east of the Rocky Mountains. In November Seattle averages more rain than any other U.S.

city of more than 250 000 people it also ranks highly in winter precipitation. Seattle experiences significant rain snowfall throughout the year averaging 1009 mm of precipitation annually. However this abundant rainfall is not evenly distributed with a distinct dry season during certain months.

View monthly and yearly rainfall data, historical precipitation records, and climate change effects on Seattle's weather patterns. Seattle averages 39.34 inches of precipitation a year, with the vast majority falling as rain instead of snow.

Official precipitation totals for the city are measured at Sea-Tac Airport, which is actually located south of the Seattle city limits. Jul 31, 2024: Remarkably, despite being in a region known for its rainfall, the city observes just under nine days of rain on average per month, with the highest frequency in November at 9.1 days and the lowest in August at 2.8 days.
