Mar 27 2025 The latest DrewryWorldContainerIndex WCI released on March 27 2025 reveals a continued decrease in global container freight rates reflecting ongoing adjustments within the maritime shipping industry For many years World Container Index WCI has been the go to independent global reference for index linked contracts

Drewry's World Container Index increased 1% to \$2 213 per 40ft container this May 2 2025 The Drewry WCI composite index decreased 3% to \$2 091 per 40ft container 80% below the previous pandemic peak of \$10 377 in September 2021

However the index was 47% higher than the composite index has increased by 1.7% to \$1 790.60 this week and has dropped by 72.2% when compared with the same week last year

The latest Drewry WCI composite index of \$1 790.60 per 40 foot container is now 83% below the peak of \$10 377 reached in September 2021 In 2021 container traffic resumed its growth reaching 849 million TEUs following stimulus packages across several economies and shifts in consumption patterns In this article we will discuss the implications of the WCI for the container shipping industry the limitations of the WCI how it compares to other container freight rate indices and provide a conclusion

The WCI is calculated using a weighted average of freight rates on eight major trade routes which are updated on a weekly basis Mar 13 2025 The Drewry WCI composite index fell 7% this week closing at \$2 368 per 40ft container

This is a 77% fall from the pandemic high of \$10 377 in September 2021 and the lowest since January 2024 Feb 14 2025 Drewry's World Container Index WCI dropped five per cent for the week of Feb

10 14 to US\$3 095 per 40 ft container marking the fifth straight week of declines Jan 17 2025 Drewry's latest World Container Index WCI reveals a 3% drop in shipping rates bringing the average to \$3 855 per 40 foot container as of 16 January 2025

This represents a significant decline of 63% from the pandemic peak of \$10 377 in September 2021 but remains 171% higher than the pre pandemic 2019 average of \$1 420 Apr 4 2025 The Drewry WCI composite index rose 2% to \$2 208 per 40ft container 79% below the previous pandemic peak of \$10 377 in September 2021.
