The difference between the English phrases Happyabout Something and Happywith Something lies in how we express our joy or satisfaction regarding something

Happyabout Something means that we are happy or experiencing positive emotions due to a specific situation event or news be happy with be happy with = be satisfied with something you possess or have experienced I am happy with my girlfriend

be happy about = be pleased by be glad that something happened He is not happy about the scores he got in the math quiz. Sometimes happy with and happy about are quite interchangeable Happy New Year! Happy New Year is the correct way. ! Years is the plural form of year as in many years

If you have heard Happy New Years it's either a misspelling or it could be interpreted as year s as in Happy New Year s Day or Happy New Year s Eve. Happy new year is correct

We do not say Happy New Years! happy about polyglotwannabe25 about a certain subject in mind I'm happy about this or that with joining two or more things together. Or grouped together

I'm happy with you you can also use with for describing emotions about certain things I'm happy with my grades although it doesn't sound too natural about would be better in this context but it's understandable Happy End ihsann In the phrase happy ending as you know ending is a gerund an ing word that's formed from a verb but functions as a noun

Both the noun end and the gerund ending mean among other things a conclusion. So happy end and happy ending would seem to mean the same thing. Although both are technically correct happy ending happytime The first is singular and the second plural

You would use happytime for a single specific event That last holiday was a happytime

You would use happytimes for a more sweeping statement often in response to someone else recalling something from the past Do you remember when we used to go to the match every Saturday as kids? Oh yes they were happytimes happy go lucky2Hinative delighted They're all pretty similar

Glad means you're satisfied at the result of something. I'm glad that my team won. Happy is more general and the most commonly used
