During the sack of Troy Astyanax still a small child was viciously killed by either Neoptolemus or Odysseus who hurled him from the city walls

[1] Who were Astyanax's parents? A Astyanax's father was Hector the eldest son of King Priam and Queen Hecuba of Troy and thus Argument The Death of Hector The Trojans being safe within the walls Hector only stays to oppose Achilles

Priam is struck at his approach and tries to persuade his son to re enter the town. Hecuba joins her entreaties but in vain. Hector consults within himself what measures to take but at the advance of Achilles his resolution fails him and he flies

Achilles pursues him thrice round Feb 9 2023 Andromache daughter of King Eetion of Cilician Thebes was the wife of Hector and mother of Astyanax. A devoted wife and mother she lost her husband and son in the Trojan War after which she herself was taken to Greece as a captive The Argument

neas relates how the city of Troy was taken after a ten years siege by the treachery of Sinon and the stratagem of a wooden horse. He declares the fixed resolution he had taken not to survive the ruins of his country and the various adventures he met with in the defense of it

At last having been before advised by Hector's ghost and now by the appearance of Mar 1 2023 The Iliad said to have been composed by Homer is an epic poem that was probably originally put into writing during the middle of the eighth century BCE

Set during the famous Trojan War the poem describes the events following a quarrel between Achilles and Agamemnon Argument The Episodes of Glaucus and Diomed and of Hector and Andromache The gods having left the field the Grecians prevail

Helenus the chief augur of Troy commands Hector to return to the city in order to appoint a solemn procession of the queen and the Trojan matrons to the temple of Minerva to entreat her to remove Diomed from the fight

The battle relaxing during the absence of Argument The Embassy to Achilles Agamemnon after the last day's defeat proposes to the Greeks to quit the siege and return to their country. Diomed opposes this and Nestor seconds him praising his wisdom and resolution
