I have struggled with what to do with uncapped frames or times when even capped honey holds too much moisture to be considered safely cured.

With the current monsoon here in the Mar 21 2020 I bought a lot of honey when traveling but now the honey is separated and I am concerned whether something was added to the honey to cause the separation. The crystalized part is very fluffy and like snow but very light. Oct 5 2024 Yup fall honey here in CT.

The dark color is a result of the fall flow knotweed actually red brown, goldenrod and asters. Maybe even some lanternfly honeydew along the coast. The thickness is likely the extraction temp. Honey pulled at 85 in July flows better than in Sept at 70.

Commercial beekeepers often have a hot room to heat up supers and speed up extracting. Have you tested with a Jul 11 2025 how much was honey worth before refined sugar? What about in ancient times? It must've been very valuable.
