Adhesive capsulitis is characterised by gradual increase in stiffness and pain. This self limiting disorder has three stages with the mean duration of 30 months for untreated cases with some subsequent restricting of movement of the shoulder1 3 4

The incidence of frozen shoulder is only <2% Sep 4 2025 While frozen shoulder only affects about two to five percent of the population it can take years to heal

Symptoms usually start slowly and get worse over time. But within one to three years symptoms typically get better

Your risk for developing frozen shoulder increases if you must keep your shoulder still for a long time. If left untreated frozen shoulder can lead to prolonged pain severe stiffness and long term mobility restrictions making everyday activities such as dressing lifting or reaching overhead difficult

Over time untreated frozen shoulder may cause permanent joint tightness and muscle weakness significantly impacting quality of life Aug 19 2022 Frozen shoulder also called adhesive capsulitis involves stiffness and pain in the shoulder joint. Signs and symptoms typically begin slowly then get worse

Over time symptoms get better usually within 1 to 3 years. Having to keep a shoulder still for a long period increases the risk of developing frozen shoulder

This might happen after having surgery or breaking an arm. Frozen shoulder can lead to long term complications such as Chronic pain. While pain may decrease over time some individuals experience persistent discomfort

Limited range of motion Without proper treatment the shoulder's mobility may remain limited even after the initial pain subsides May 24 2023 Frozen shoulder adhesive capsulitis is when the protective capsule around the shoulder joint contracts causing pain and restricting movement.
