Many of his works remain classics of European and Scottish literature notably the novels *Ivanhoe* 1819 *Rob Roy* 1817 *Waverley* 1814 *Old Mortality* 1816 *The Heart of Mid Lothian* 1818 and *The Bride of Lammermoor* 1819 along with the narrative poems *Marmion* 1808 and *Dec 21 2025 Sir Walter Scott born August 15 1771 Edinburgh Scotland died September 21 1832 Abbotsford Roxburgh Scotland was a Scottish novelist poet historian and biographer who is often considered both the inventor and the greatest practitioner of the historical novel Sir Walter Scott Year by Year Chronological Biography 1771 1832 Sir Walter Scott 15 August 1771 21 September 1832 was a Scottish novelist poet lawyer and historian who pioneered the historical novel genre*

Renowned for works like *Waverley* *Rob Roy* *Ivanhoe* and *The Lady of the Lake* Scott wove Scotland's history and folklore into popular literature

He was deeply involved in Born in Edinburgh Scotland influential novelist poet and historian and biographer Sir Walter Scott studied law as an apprentice to his father before his writing career flourished

At age 25 he published his first work *The Chase* and *William and Helen* 1796 a translation of two Romantic ballads by the German balladeer G.A

Brger Sir Walter Scott was born on 15 August 1771 in a small third floor flat in College Wynd in Edinburgh's Old Town. Scott was the ninth child of Anne Rutherford and Walter Scott a solicitor and member of the private Scottish society known as the Writers of the Signet so called for their entitlement to use the Scottish Kings seal known as the signet when drawing up legal documents Dec 25 2025 Sir Walter Scott 1771 1832 The Architect of Scotland's National Identity Introduction Sir Walter Scott 1771 1832 stands as one of the defining figures of both Scottish and global literary history

As the father of historical fiction Scott transformed Scotland's past into a source of cultural strength and national pride
