Feb 14 2021 Chain jumping every few crank rotations Ask Question Asked 4 years 10 months ago Modified 4 years 10 months ago Nov 14 2025 I have an old 1990s Kona Lava Dome 3x7 speed which has developed a nasty jump skip under load across a wide range all gears

On inspection the chain was past its 1% limit and the jockey wheels or Oct 17 2020 Once one becomes experienced in jumping and starts to reliably clear middle sized jumps simply doing them can become quite boring

A medium sized jump gives a couple to 5 seconds of flight time which feels like a lot to the rider

You simply hang in air doing nothing! Whipping is an easy relatively safe and good looking trick to learn at this point Nov 22 2024 Some weeks ago I started to have the problem that when applying a lot of power to the pedals the chain was slipping not jumping to another gear but just slipping

This was particularly problematic when pedaling up hill or when starting from still position Apr 21 2024 1 This is an easy fix albeit I will caution you what I refer to as chain jumping is one of the more dangerous scenarios when riding a bicycle

Each time it jumps from pushing hard on the pedal the worse it becomes

For the moderator my experience comes from building over 400 bicycles 2 3 of these vintage mountain bike conversions to road Aug 18 2024 Any chance you could get a video of the jumping happening? Also a picture of the cassette and chainring to evaluate wear would be nice

What model chain was the old one and what's the new one? The problem is likely due not to anything from the chain or the cogs but rather cable tension. If the chain is trying to shift onto bigger lower gear cogs then the cable is too tight. The chain will keep trying to catch the next larger cog

If it's too loose it will try to shift to the next smaller cog. presuming a standard derailleur setup some are backwards Try this. Shift to the Nov 6 2017 You mean while the bike is in mid air? The change in angular momentum will induce a very slight forward tilt

Of course if you engage the front brake in mid air and hold it while you land the forward tilt will be quite a bit more pronounced in the worst case you would break your neck Nov 11 2023 Bike chain jumping at lowest and highest gear fine in the middle Ask Question Asked 2 years 1 month ago Modified 2 years 1 month ago This is a pretty common concern with cyclocross
