When James Earl Carter died at his home in Plains, Georgia, on December 29, 2024, he was 100 and many people who as 18-year-olds had voted for or against him in the 1970s were contemplating. At its height, LIFE magazine's incomparable images and essays reached 1 of 3 American readers. The original prints, negatives, and associated manuscripts remain in the Dotdash Merediths LIFE Picture Collection, an unprecedented cultural asset with millions of untold stories and unseen images.
