The movement spread to the United States in the late 1880s with the opening of the Neighborhood Guild in New York City's Lower East Side in 1886 and the most famous settlement house in the United States Hull House 1889 was founded soon after by Jane Addams and Ellen Starr in Chicago. In 1889 Jane Addams and Ellen Gates Starr launched Hull House in Chicago.

As word of these experiments spread other settlements appeared in New York, Boston, Philadelphia, and Chicago. Hull House inspired Charles Zueblin to organize Northwestern University Settlement in 1891. In 1884 British university students opened the first settlement house Toynbee Hall in London's impoverished East End with the goal of promoting cross class understanding. The purpose of this paper is to enrich our understanding of accountability by exploring how it was conceptualized and put into action at the Hull House settlement, a non profit organization established in Chicago at the turn of the century. Although Hull House and other settlements helped establish separate institutions for Black neighborhoods, pioneered in studying Black urban communities and helped organize the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, Blacks were not welcome at the major settlements. US settlement houses such as Hull House and University Settlement were influenced by Toynbee Hall in England.

Toynbee Hall was founded in 1884 by Canon Samuel A. Barnett. To isolate the debt which Chicago architecture owed Hull House, on 22 October 1897 the Chicago Arts and Crafts Society was founded. It was first necessary to establish the Arts and Crafts Society.

Within six months the background that is to consider the history of the Arts group and expanded to some 128 members and was inexorably patterned after a British settlement house. Addams enlarged greatly on this model and offered Chicago immigrants around Hull House services that included everything from day care to acting as an employment bureau. In 1888 while traveling together in Europe Addams and Starr decided to open a settlement house patterned after London's Toynbee Hall.

In 1889 using Addams' money and donations from the parents of Starr's pupils, the two bought a run down mansion on Chicago's West Side. This settlement method included having interested well to do people settle in the slums by living in the settlement house.

Learning about poverty from first hand experience these settlement workers would gain added insights into its causes and added legitimacy in their arguments for its solutions.
