As the country's economy prospered, it was bound to want a modern army. Modernism was an early 20th century movement in literature, visual arts, performing arts, and music that emphasized experimentation, abstraction, and subjective experience.

[2] Philosophy, politics, architecture, and social issues were all aspects of this movement. Modernism centered around beliefs in a growing alienation from prevailing morality, optimism, and convention [3] and a Modernism applied to those things that exist in the present age, especially

in contrast to those of a former age or an age long past. Hence the word "modern" sometimes has the connotation of "up to date" and thus good modern ideas. What does "modern" mean? "Modern" means relating to the present time, as in "modern life". It also means "up to date" and not "old" as in "modern technology".

Apart from these general senses, "modern" is often used in a more specific way to refer to the current historical period, modern meaning definition, what is modern, belonging to the present time or most recent.
