A physical examination follows during which the doctor listens to the heart and assesses overall health. Mar 24 2022 The most common reason people get a pacemaker is their heart beats too slowly, called bradycardia, or it pauses, causing fainting spells or other symptoms.

In some cases, the pacemaker may also be used to prevent or treat a heartbeat that is too fast, tachycardia, or irregular.

These problems may be caused by problems with electrical signaling in your heart. Beta blockers, which are medicines, pacemakers only work when needed and can be programmed to act during episodes of bradycardia, atrial fibrillation, or cardiac arrest.

Depending on your condition, you might have one of the following pacemaker devices:

- Single chamber pacemaker: Carries electrical impulses to the right ventricle of the heart.
- A pacemaker: A small device that sends electric impulses to restore the heart's rhythm and maintain a regular heart rate.

Pacemakers are used to treat arrhythmias like atrial fibrillation, also known as AFib, which are problems with the rate or rhythm of the heartbeat. You may need a pacemaker.
