Get away from the area, get clean, and get medical care if exposed Sep 6 2024. Background: Strychnine is a strong poison. Only a small amount is needed to cause serious effects in people. Strychnine poisoning can cause extremely serious negative health effects including death.

Strychnine is a white, odorless, bitter, crystalline powder. It can be taken by mouth, breathed in, or mixed in a solution and given intravenously or injected directly into a vein Sep 6 2024. Chlorine is a liquid or gas with a strong, irritating smell.

Signs and symptoms of chlorine exposure depend on how you were exposed. Get away from the area, get clean, and get help if exposed. Chlorine can explode with many common substances Sep 6 2024. VX is a human-made chemical warfare agent. It is one of the most toxic nerve agents.
