So there is no pattern to whether or not you use an apostrophe We tend to use the middle of thenight to refer to just as you guessed a general time or time period during the part of thenightwhere most people are probably asleep

Another phrase you might hear is in the dead ofnight with dead referring to the stillness and quietness at that time. Midnight is then simply 12am Use of prepositions in English is not a case of why but rather a case of because that is the way we do it

Generally we use on with specific days or dates. Sunday evening is a specific day. If we were to use the evening on its own it could refer to any evening and is not therefore a specific day or date

Basically when we use the Present Perfect it means that something has happened at some point in our lives before now. Remember the exact time the action happened is not important. Examples Anightowl or evening person is a person who tends to stay up until late atnight

The opposite of anightowl is an early bird a lark as opposed to owl someone who tends to begin sleeping at a time that is considered early and also wakes early Mar 20 2018 Speaking both PM AM and o clock together is odd! It s 4 PM o clock no no Now it depends on the context

If someone is asking you now obviously both of you know the part of the day ornigh. It makes no sense to add PM if the person is asking you in the afternoon. Yes this is okay if you are teaching someone when to say PM AM
