Dutch Bengal [1][2] was a directorate of the Dutch East India Company in Mughal Bengal between 1610 until the company's liquidation in 1800. It then became a colony of the Kingdom of the Netherlands until 1825 when it was relinquished to the British according to the Anglo Dutch Treaty of 1824

[3] Dutch presence in the region started by the establishment of a trading post at Pipili in the mouth of Subarnarekha River in Odisha

The former colony is part of what is today called Dutch India. In an attempt to rediscover this rich heritage the Embassy of the Netherlands in collaboration with Indian partners is encouraging research as well as physical restoration of buildings records and archival material

With the defeat of Siraj ud Daula the Nawab of Bengal in the Battle of Plassey in 1757 the British established supremacy in Bengal. Furthermore during the Third Anglo Dutch War 1672-74 links between Surat and the new English town of Bombay were disrupted resulting in the Dutch forces capturing three homebound English ships in the Bay of Bengal. The Early Bengal Oils often referred to as French or Dutch Bengal Oils emerged in the late 18th and early 19th centuries in Bengal particularly in the French colony of Chandernagore and the Dutch colony of Chinsurah

These paintings were a result of the cultural exchanges between European settlers and Indian artists integrating Western oil painting techniques with indigenous artistic traditions. The first British settlement in Bengal was established in Hugli in 1651 and later abandoned in 1690 in favor of Kolkata

In 1656 the Dutch East India Company created an independent directorate in Bengal. Peter Sterkhemius the first director chose Hugli as its headquarter. Dutch East India Company was the first northern European corporate enterprise to establish factories in India
