The solution in that thread works perfectly for Office 2016 however the Windows has this nifty little shortcut for running commands

Press Windows+r

Problem is is there an easy way to have the commands I run in that dialog to prompt for a UAC credentials dialog and Oct 18 2013 How do I run as a different user AND run in an elevated context?
