Sep 19 2025 Commission for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living ResourcesA. OverviewAntarctica is surrounded by an unbroken and dynamic body of water known as the Southern Ocean which constitutes about 10% of the world s total ocean surface

For about 200 years Antarctica s resources have been unsystematically harvested

In many cases the intense level of exploitation resulted in the severe depletion of harvested stocks as was the case for fur and elephant seals in the 19th century and whales Sep 15 2021 The remarkable story of the battle to save the ozone layer starts with science

In the mid 1970s scientists warned that man made chemicals in everyday products like aerosols foams refrigerators and air conditioners were harming the ozone layer. At that time they didnt know the scale of the problem. But in 1985 a hole was confirmed in the ozone layer over Antarctica

Mangroves and seagrass meadows are coastal ecosystems that cover a small portion of the total ocean area but collectively are widely distributed on every continent except Antarctica

Mangroves are found in 123 countries worldwide with an estimated area of 15.2 million hectares while seagrasses occur in 159 countries covering over 30 million Jan 29 2025 In 1985 three British scientists published a paper in the journal Nature that revealed there was a large hole in the ozone layer above the Antarctic

The research sent shockwaves around the world. The ozone layer shields the planet from the suns harmful ultraviolet radiation and its loss would decimate life on Earth Jan 7 2025 Some researchers believe the outbreak is a sign of things to come

As climate change rapidly warms the Artic scientists say it could unleash a wave of potentially deadly microbes that for centuries have been trapped in ice In 2023 the world saw new highs of greenhouse gas emissions temperature records tumbling and climate impacts arriving stronger and faster

At the same time most of the Sustainable Development Goals SDGs were off track at the halfway point of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development Jan 9 2023
