Seduce is also commonly used in a more general way meaning to tempt or influence someone to do something especially something bad or something they wouldn't normally do To attract or lead someone away from proper behavior or thinking He had been in this way seduced from the wisdom of his cooler judgment Anthony Trollope Seduce means something close to attract beguile tempt and mislead
