To seduce someone is to make them want to engage in sexual activity with you especially in a subtle or manipulative way.

Seduce is also commonly used in a more general way meaning to tempt or influence someone to do something especially something bad or something they wouldn't normally do to lead or draw away from principles, faith or allegiance. He was seduced by the prospect of gain. To attract or lead someone away from proper behavior or thinking. He had been in this way seduced from the wisdom of his cooler judgment. Anthony Trollope. Seduce means something close to attract, beguile, tempt and mislead.

The word often has romantic overtones but it doesn't have to. A clever criminal could seduce someone into a life of crime.

When you're being seduced, it implies you're being tricked a little bit often into something that's enticing but not so good. Seen positively, seduction is a synonym for the act of charming someone male or female by an appeal to the senses often with the goal of reducing unfounded fears and leading to their sexual emancipation.
