Medicines Reflux medicines aren t typically used in children to treat reflux that isn t complicated. But a healthcare professional may recommend an acid blocking medicine for several weeks or months

Acid blocking medicines include cimetidine Tagamet HB famotidine Pepcid AC and Jan 21 2025 Absence seizures usually can be managed with antiseizure medicines. Some children who have them also develop other seizures such as generalized tonic clonic seizures or myoclonic seizures
