He is at his wits end trying to figure it out but his teacher does not help him. I have no clue what I am doing and tried using AI but that didn't help. The task is Create a script that allows a user to input a series of names and store them in a variable list L

The list should allow the user to continue entering names until they Mar 24 2025 In this week's module we will begin exploring how to create games in Snap!

Since games tend to be more complex this module will extend across multiple weeks as we develop concepts, create first drafts, and then refine mechanics and features

As a jumping off point please review the documents on the course page for the module on Designing Feb 12 2025. Alas, Snap!'s scheduler doesn't do real time slicing; it relies on explicit yields that Snap! carries out at the bottom of every loop iteration.

So if the first script doesn't have any loop blocks, for example, it uses recursion instead, it'll win the race even if it actually takes more time than the second script Nov 19 2025. Scratchers coming to Snap! generally don't like the old style Scratch 1.4 look of Snap! as they are used to Scratch 3's appearance.

If the visual block changes could be incorporated into Snap! as an optional skin, then it would be a big win for block programming progression. Thanks for the very kind words Feb 9 2025.
