Toccata from Italian toccare literally to touch with toccata being the action of touching is a virtuoso piece of music typically for a keyboard or plucked string instrument featuring fast moving lightly fingered or otherwise virtuosic passages or sections with or without imitative or fugal interludes generally emphasizing the ThemeaningofTOCCATAis a musical composition usually for organ or harpsichord in a free style and characterized by full chords rapid runs and high harmonies Toccata musical form for keyboard instruments written in a free style that is characterized by full chords rapid runs high harmonies and other virtuoso elements designed to show off the performers touch

The earliest use of the term about 1536 was associated with solo lute music of an Jul 25 2022 Put simply toccata is the musical term for an instrumental composition that gives the musician chance to show off their range of skills

A term typically used in relation to pieces performed on keyboard instruments organs pianos harpsichords etc toccatas might include lots of fast runs embellishments and full chords to demonstrate the players dexterity to its full extent TOCCATAdefinition 1
