The Osborne 1 is the first commercially successful portable computer released on April 3 1981 by Osborne Computer Corporation

[1] It weighs 24.5 lb 11.1 kg cost US\$1 795 and runs the CP/M 2.2 operating system Released in June 1981 by the Osborne Computer Corporation the Osborne 1 is considered to be the first true portable full featured computer

It includes all the components required to be a completely useful and operational computer system a built in albeit small monochrome CRT monitor 4 days ago In April 1981 writer and computer entrepreneur Adam Osborne and Osborne Computer Corporation Hayward California produced the first commercially successful portable computer the Osborne 1 May 23 2025 First released on April 3 1981 Osborne 1 is touted as the first commercially successful portable computer manufactured by the Osborne Computer Corporation

It runs on the CP/M 2.2 operating system and is powered from a wall socket Dec 22 2025 The Osborne 1 was introduced in 1981 at the West Coast Computer Faire

The portable computer was based on the Z80A CPU which ran at 4MHz had 64K RAM and 4K ROM a 5 inch display screen two 5.25 inch floppy disk drives and a detachable full sized keyboard The Osborne 1 or OCC 1 was the first portable computer to get to market and become a commercial success

Released in 1981 by the Osborne Computer Corporation the unit weighed in at a hefty 23.5lb and cost a whopping \$1795 Weighing 10.7kg the Osborne 1 was the first system designed to be transported between the office and the home and was a precursor to the modern laptop

The computer cost \$1795 when it was released in April 1981 and was advertised as the only computer that would fit under the seat on an aeroplane The Osborne 1 is the first mass produced portable computer a suitcase sized luggable system weighing 23.5 pounds

It was one of the first bundled systems with an inclusive package of hardware and software including word processing spreadsheet and BASIC programs The Osborne 1 history and design of the first portable personal computer designed by Lee Felsenstein and produced by Osborne Corporation from 1981 to 1983 In 1981 Adam Osborne produced what is generally considered to be the first truly portable computer.
