Sep 22 2010 super is a special use of the super keyword where you call a parameterless parent constructor

In general the super keyword can be used to call overridden methods access hidden fields or invoke a superclass's constructor Feb 23 2009 super lets you avoid referring to the base class explicitly which can be nice

But the main advantage comes with multiple inheritance where all sorts of fun stuff can happen Nov 3 2015 The one without super hard codes its parent's method thus it has restricted the behavior of its method and subclasses cannot inject functionality in the call chain. The one with super has greater flexibility. The call chain for the methods can be intercepted and functionality injected In fact multiple inheritance is the only case where super is of any use

I would not recommend using it with classes using linear inheritance where it's just useless overhead I'm currently learning about class inheritance in my Java course and I don't understand when to use the super call? Edit I found this example of code where super.variable is used class A { Jul 23 2009 The automatic insertion of super by the compiler allows this

Enforcing super to appear first enforces that constructor bodies are executed in the correct order which would be Object > Parent > Child > ChildOfChild > So On So Forth Dec 18 2024 super object has no attribute \_\_sklearn\_tags\_\_. This occurs when I invoke the fit method on the RandomizedSearchCV object

I suspect it could be related to compatibility issues between Scikit learn and XGBoost or Python version. I am using Python 3.12 and both Scikit learn and XGBoost are installed with their latest versions

I attempted to tune the hyperparameters of an XGBRegressor As for chaining super as I mentioned in the question I have still to find an interesting use to that

For now I only see it as a hack but it was worth mentioning if only for the differences with Java where you can't chain super Jul 9 2018 I wrote the following code
