Toriigates were traditionally made from wood or stone but today they can be also made of reinforced concrete stainless steel and other materials

They are usually either unpainted or painted vermilion with a black upper lintel. The torii often painted bright red demarcates the boundary between the sacred space of the shrine and ordinary space.
