I believe you should use Travels for your root folder name. The folder is a photographic chronicle of your travels as you would say and the pluralization reflects the further division into different locations

I think this would be more correct than calling the folder travel although travel could also work if you looked at the collection of pictures as a single entity Jul 16 2015 In this case travels is likely correct and possibly more so than the singular version

The implication is that the person being addressed is or will be engaged in some sort of extended traveling method does not matter and hence more than one travel. For the case of a simple trip however Have a safe trip would be more idiomatic
