In British brass band music the tenor trombone is treated as a B transposing instrument written in treble clef and the alto trombone is written at concert pitch usually in alto clef

A person who plays the trombone is called a trombonist or trombone player. Trombone is a brass wind musical instrument sounded by lip vibration against a cup mouthpiece. It has an extendable slide that can increase the length of the instrument's tubing. The current name of the instrument means large trumpet.

In German, this instrument is called a Posaune, which originally meant trumpet.
