Known for its potent viper venom retractable fangs and deadly strikes the viper snake family has evolved to thrive in diverse environments Oct 13 2025 There are approximately 200 members of species that belong to the Viper Viperidae family

Vipers include true vipers bush vipers rattlesnakes pit vipers adders and night adders. The fangs of vipers are long and hollow and enable the snake to inject venom into animals that it bites Vipers represent a fascinating and often misunderstood group of snakes

Characterized by their hinged fangs and typically potent venom these reptiles play a critical role in ecosystems worldwide Vipers are a group of snakes in the family Viperidae that inhabit all continents except Australia and Antarctica and are found in nearly all terrestrial ecosystems from deserts to moist tropical forests Aug 18 2025 Vipers are a diverse group of venomous snakes

They are characterized by specific anatomical adaptations their widespread presence across various global environments and the particular nature of their venom. Vipers belong to the family Viperidae united by shared anatomical traits Viper snakes are found in Americas Africa Eurasia

In the Americas they live from southern Canada through the United States Mexico Central America and into South America. The only type of viper which lives in the United Kingdom are the adders.
