That iswhy And goes on to explain There is a subtle but important difference between the use of that and which in a sentence and it has to do primarily with relevance

Grammarians often use the terms restrictive and non restrictive when it comes to relative clauses Dec 2 2011 Since we can say Whycan we grow taller? Whycannot we grow taller? is a logical and properly written negative

We don t say Whywe can grow taller? so the construct should not be Whywe cannot grow taller? The reason is that auxiliaries should come before the subject to make an interrogative Good explanation ofwhyit s optional in this case although I m not convinced that reason is the only reasonable antecedent ofwhy

For example the explanationwhyis a common usage and I don t think you can freely substitute that in that case either
