If it matters the report format only displays a maximum of two years at a time this year and last year Happy New Year! is a sentence by itself and thus Happy should be capitalized. It would not be necessary to capitalize birthday if you were saying Happy birthday instead of Happy New Year

I wish you a merry Christmas and happy New Year. is how I d capitalize the words if they weren t being used on their own but rather in a longer sentence These second and final years give the impression that you mean one specific year which was at the same time your second as well as your final year

For example In the fifth and last year of the war the motivation was dwindling. Of course in your sentence this interpretation is impossible because you use between but I did get confused at first Oct 27 2015 You ve helped us with our thesis statements in this year

You ve helped us with our thesis statements this year. Both sentences have the same meaning and are both fine grammatically but by convention in is not usually used to refer to the current year and will sound strange to native speakers. You should use sentence 2
