Included are sections on symptoms treatment diagnosis prevention and WHO's work in this area Jul 10 2025 Yellow fever is an epidemic prone vector borne vaccine preventable viral disease that is transmitted to humans by the bites of infected mosquitos

In some of the unvaccinated individuals the virus can cause severe illness including jaundice and bleeding severe cases Mar 2 2017 Yellow fever occurs in 47 endemic countries in Africa in Central and South America. Around 90% of cases reported every year occur in Sub Saharan Africa

Infected travellers from areas where yellow fever occurs can export cases to countries that are free of yellow fever but the disease can only spread easily if that country has the mosquito species able to transmit it specific climatic Yellow fever YF is an infection caused by a virus of the family Flaviviridae and it is transmitted by mosquitoes. Yellow fever is an epidemic prone vaccine preventable disease caused by an arbovirus transmitted to humans primarily through the bites of an infected Aedes spp

and Haemagogus spp. mosquitoes. The incubation period ranges from 3 to 6 days

Many infected people do not experience symptoms but when they occur the most common are fever muscle pain with prominent back pain headache loss of Jul 10 2025 It is recommended that the yellow fever vaccine be given to infants at age 9-12 months at the same time as the measles vaccine in yellow fever endemic countries

All countries with areas at risk of yellow fever disease should aim to reach and sustain high coverage through routine immunization services Dec 1 2021 The International Coordinating Group on Vaccine Provision for Yellow Fever ICG which oversees the global emergency stockpile for YF outbreak response has approved a larger scale vaccination campaign targeting 361 165 people 9 months 60 years in five affected districts Public health aspects Yellow fever YF is a mosquito borne viral haemorrhagic fever that is endemic in tropical areas of Africa and South America where it has caused outbreaks at irregular intervals for centuries

Like plague and cholera YF is subject to control measures outlined in the International health regulations

WHO estimates that a total of 200 000 cases of YF occur each year Oct 20 2025 2713 67 000 173 May 1 2020 DISEASE AND VACCINE CHARACTERISTICS Yellow fever YF is caused by a Flavivirus and is transmitted by several species of infected mosquitoes e.g. Haemagogus and Aedes spp
